Horizon is a summer day camp for children with cancer and their siblings—100% free of charge. Horizon campers are welcome to come for the entire summer or as little as one day. Every day, our campers return home filled with stories and experiences that will last a lifetime.


Days at Horizon are filled with friends, games, songs and fun—the perfect antidote to long, lonely days at home and in the hospital. **Horizon campers are given what every child deserves—the opportunity to be a kid**.

At Horizon children can come to camp and continue treatment with their home doctors and return home to the comfort of their own beds at the end of each day.

The Horizon Day Camp staff team includes a **medical director**, **on-site nurses**, and a **dedicated camp staff** specially trained to meet the unique needs of our children, while also providing a fun and memorable summer.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Ages 3½ to 16
- Within five years of active or follow-up treatment for cancer
- Siblings ages 3½ to 16 of eligible campers
- If child with cancer is unable to attend, siblings are still welcome



A TYPICAL DAY AT

HORIZON DAY CAMP*

OPTIONAL EARLY MORNING

We have a rolling start to the day beginning at **7:30**_{AM} to accommodate working families. Our early campers are given a light breakfast and get a head start on the fun with their counselors.

WELCOME TO CAMP

Campers step off the counselor-staffed bus at camp around 9:30_{AM} and are greeted by big smiles, dancing counselors and a hand-picked playlist. Buses pick up campers from convenient locations all over the region. They are about to have THE BEST DAY EVER!

ROUND-UP!

The entire camp comes together to start the day with camp songs, spirited cheers, announcements and a kick-off to a fun-filled day at camp.

MORNING ACTIVITIES

Campers are immersed with their friends in one of **dozens of choice activities**. Our camps have art, yoga, drama, STEAM, basketball, soccer, water play and so much more—**there is something for everyone!**

LUNCH TIME!

Campers eat their **bagged lunch brought from home**. Horizon provides snacks throughout the day. We are nut-aware, and we can accommodate special dietary needs. Sandwich options are available for campers who forget their lunch.

COOL DOWN

Splash and cool off in the pool. Free swim and lessons are provided throughout the week. To cool down throughout the day, campers have access to indoor air-conditioned facilities and misting tents.

ICE CREAM TIME!

Campers top off an amazing day at camp with a **frozen treat** and a closing round up, together as a full camp for one final song and cheer.

SEE YA REAL SOON

Campers are dismissed to their bus or to parent/guardian pick-up. As with early-drop off, we offer a rolling pick-up time to accommodate working families until 6:30pm.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

Every Horizon Camp is supported by a **medical director**, as well as **on-site nurses**. All camps have a private, air-conditioned Wellness Center from which most medications can be easily administered. Ample indoor areas are also provided for children to just "cool down and rest." In the unlikely event of an emergency during the camp day, staff-accompanied emergency transportation by ambulance is available.

YEAR-ROUND SUPPORT

Our staff and volunteers roll rainbow trunks bursting with games and toys into the hospital and transform difficult and scary days into a day of magical camp fun!
